We're raising \$128 million to construct a purpose-built facility that will give our youth the services and support they need to succeed—all under one roof.

THE BUILDING

Our new building will be so much more than a shelter. It's designed from the ground up to get our city's homeless youth back on their feet and on the path to independence. We'll have the capacity to work with over 120 young people at a time, and over 1,900 annually.

KEY FEATURES

- > 80,720 square feet
- > Six floors of residential shelter
- Six floors of program spaces for personalized wraparound services, including outreach, legal services, life skills development, recreation, and youth guidance programs
- > 1,900 youth to be impacted annually
- Federally qualified Health Center located on the ground floor to ensure timely and efficient access, for both drop-in and in-house services
- Employment Training and Education Services for more access to counseling, classes, technology, and specialized training
- > 1,500 square feet of outdoor green space for healing and meditation
